The PRCC Family Retreat is a retreat for any PR family—young or not so young, married or single, families with young kids, teenagers, or no kids. This retreat is for you. The dates for this year’s retreat are October 4-6. The retreat will be held at Pettijohn Springs Christian Camp outside of Madill, OK. This is the facility where we hold Camp HB each year. Each family is in their own cabin, and a cabin for single women and one for single men will be available. The cost of the retreat is \$35 per person ages 11 and up. For kids ages 5-10, the cost is \$30 per person. Kids four and under are free. Cost includes four meals and your lodging. Registration forms can be found at PR Central in the Atrium.
