## A NOTE FROM DEAN

Hi Church,

I wanted to take this space today to just share with you a little bit about the friendliness part of the strategic planning we have been working on.

We have identified that one ministry area we could be giving more attention to is our guests. Did you know we have between 1-3 families every week who have never set foot on our property? That comes out to around 100 families a year who worship with us for the first time. However, we are finding that only a small percentage of those families come back for a second visit and even fewer who ultimately place membership. Of course, there are a lot of factors that play a role in this, but one factor we believe we have control over is a great first impression and a great follow-up.

That's why we will be implementing a redesigned parking lot ministry, re-upping our efforts in the greeting ministry, expanding our cafe in the future to be a more welcoming space, implementing the meet-and-greet we started last week, and using a brand new tool for more effective follow-up in our guest follow-up ministry. We want our guests to leave feeling that they were very welcome here and that Pleasant Ridge is a place they could make their home.
