A MESSAGE FROM PAT

Pleasant Ridge began 2018 with 240 senior adult members and 16 Baby Boomers who would reach at 65 sometime during the year. We began 2019 with 256 senior adult members and 22 Baby Boomers who will reach age 65 sometime this year. So our numbers continue to grow each year. Why is this the case? Primarily because 10,000 Baby Boomers are reaching age 65 EVERY DAY in the United States, and that is going to continue for another 16 years until all 70,000,000 Baby Boomers in our country reach age 65. The city of Arlington is growing older. The state of Texas is growing older. The United States is growing older. Why would we not expect the church to reflect that demographic? And it is not just in the United States. The Baby Boom is over in Germany, China, and many other countries around the world.

So the need for Senior Adult Ministry is growing all over the country. Sadly, many congregations have done little or nothing to meet the needs of their senior adult members, and what is being done in the name of Senior Adult Ministry is primarily the healthy planning events and service for the healthy, or the "go's" as I like to call them. Sooner or later, the sheer weight of numbers is going to force congregations to wake up and take action. I am thankful to say that Pleasant Ridge is setting the bar for Senior Adult Ministry in our fellowship. We are certainly far from perfect, but we are making an honest effort to meet the needs of all of our "go," "slow go," and "no go" senior adults. The number of seniors we are able to serve is determined by the number of volunteers willing to roll up their sleeves and become part of our CARING One on One Ministry.

Our 2019 Ministry Fair at PR is one month away (Sunday, February 10th). Like many ministries, our Senior Adult Ministry will have a booth that day. I hope you will stop by that morning and let Karen Collins and I share more information with you about our CARING One on One Ministry. We need more volunteers. NOW! Please consider joining forces with our ministry team to meet the needs of our "no go" and "slow go" senior adults.
