Join Us for Bible Class on Sunday Morning!

Jornada al Cielo (Clase en Español) – “Moisés y la Antigua Ley”. Moisés fue uno de los personajes más importantes de la historia judía. Desde la venida de Jesús esta ley ya no nos ata, pero hay mucho que podemos aprender de la Ley de Moisés que nos ayudará a comprender el Nuevo Testamento. FLEX Bible Study (September-November) – “Moses and the Old Law.” Moses was one of the most important characters in Jewish history. He is remembered for the plagues of Egypt and also for the Law he brought from God to the children of Israel. We usually call this collection of commandments the Law of Moses. The Jewish people have followed this Law for centuries. Jesus, the apostles, and the earliest Christians were born and lived under the Law of Moses. Since the coming of Jesus, this Law is no longer binding, but there is much that we can learn from the Law of Moses that will help us to understand the New Testament.
