A NOTE FROM BRANDON

Hey, Pleasant Ridge! Thanks for worshipping with us this morning! Here's an update about what's going on in Student Ministry. I noticed about a year ago that most of our student visitors were coming on Wednesday nights. This summer, with the help of our interns, we soft launched a mid-week service for our students. It wasn't much at first, but now it's really caught on! We decided to call it Oasis. A typical Oasis consists of a meal served at 6:30 pm, meet-and-greet, game, worship, and a lesson all starting at 7pm.

Our vision for Oasis is to make it the "peak of the week". We want our mid-week to be something that all of our students love and want to bring their friends to...and they have! Last Wednesday night, we had 43 students join us for Oasis! But what excites me the most is how many first time guests we have had. During our meet-and-greet segment, we ask that new people joining us for Oasis come get a Baskin-Robbins gift card as a token of appreciation for coming that night. We



bought 20 \$2 gift cards at the beginning of August, and we have ONE LEFT. Now I'm not good at math, but what that tells me is that in just 4 WEEKS, we have had NINETEEN visitors join us for Oasis!

Here's another exciting thing that Oasis brings to the table, OUTREACH! Throughout the school year, we are planning to have 4 outreach events during Oasis. We are encouraging all of our students to attend and bring "One Life" with them. Our first is coming up in October, where students and their friends will have an opportunity to hear a Gospel message and have an "Easter egg hunt", but with PUMPKINS. Students could walk away with a prize and maybe even some cash!

Please continuing praying for this ministry as we do whatever we can to introduce students to the Savior.
