Much of what we do at the Tri-C is with international students. And there are several reasons why we do this.

- 900,000 international students and visiting scholars currently in the US
- 60% of international students come from countries where missionaries from North America are restricted.
- 80% of those students will return home without ever being invited into an American's home.
- 10% of the international students will be reached by a Christian ministry while they are here
- 40% of the world's 220 heads of state once studied in the US

As we live in a time when churches are sending out fewer missionaries into the world, God is bringing the world to us. God is bringing the best and brightest from these countries. People who are or will be people of great influence in their home countries, maybe future presidents, prime ministers and kings. But as a nation we are not doing a very good job of taking advantage of this great opportunity God is dropping into our laps.

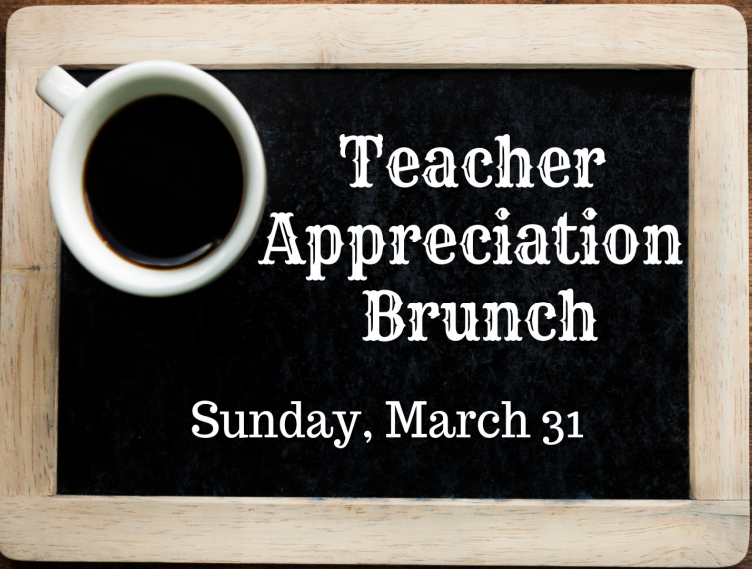
