### **Ministry Opportunity**

Question: Can you help us walk alongside students at UTA?

Today is the Ministry Fair! If you haven't already, stop by the Tri-C booth and visit with me or Cyndi Needels. We'd love to tell you about the opportunities we have for you to partner with us in serving and loving the UTA community. The Tri-C is a mission field in your own backyard, and we are looking for more workers to join us in the Kingdom work that God has given to us.

Recently, I was welcoming students as they came in to take part in the Food Pantry at the Tri-C. We ended up accommodating 106 students -breaking our previous record number of 84. One older student, Casey, shared that he was in the military when he was diagnosed with a brain tumor that led to other physical problems, including a terrible fall off a ladder. Despite being disabled, he maintained his mental capacity and has come to UTA to study computer science. With living expenses, school expenses, and medical expenses, Casey was delighted to hear about the Food Pantry through the UTA Shorthorn paper. Another student at the Food Pantry simply said, "I am a senior! I wish I knew about you guys earlier."

The Tri-C still needs more help! We need behind the scenes workers, up front workers, and we need financial help. Some examples of volunteer opportunities are helping with our Bread Run and our weekly lunch service. Some financial needs are providing money to help us pay for repairs to our cooling system for our Food Pantry and purchasing some ChromeBooks that are dedicated to our Food Pantry work. We also need food or money donated to purchase food to distribute to students like Casey. There are always so many more great things we would like to share about what we see God doing at UTA.
