Arlington Life Shelter, through gifts from several local donors, has purchased the building next door to the existing shelter facility. Plans are to demolish that building and erect a two-story 12,642 square-foot facility connected to the existing facility. The new facility will provide seven family

bedrooms to support families, women, and children, increasing space for 28-35 more individuals; classroom and small meeting room space which will allow other agencies and volunteers to come and provide needed services and programming for the homeless community including employment information and training: etc. Pleasant Ridge has partnered with the Shelter this year by donating \$1,000.00 (\$500.00 Children's Contribution; \$500.00 Community Ministry) to achieve this goal.



We've been serving Delaney Elementary school this school year in many ways. April was the last month of the school year we donated bulk snacks. This week is the last week we will provide mentoring to two students (and pray for more Pleasant Ridge mentors to help mentoring more students next school year). Two bicycles were donated a couple of weeks ago to reward a boy and a girl for demonstrating positive character traits all year long. Breakfast was provided weeks ago to the faculty and staff in appreciation for what they do for the students and their families. The first week in June we will be providing lunch to Miller Elementary school in appreciation for serving our community academically, among other things. We also started recruiting thirteen Miller Elementary students to attend Camp Pettijohn this summer. Please pray for our efforts to continue loving. caring, and serving these schools and for God to open doors to "proclaim the mystery of Christ" (Col. 4:3) with our community.
