
#### **Spring Retreat**



## ComMission Sunday and an LST Celebration!

Two special missions events will be happening next Sunday, March 1<sup>st</sup>. One is our annual *ComMission Sunday*, when we will take up a special contribution to help us carry out the Great Commission throughout the year via short-term mission trips from 1-6 weeks in length. As you have seen in PR Today and in Sunday morning videos, plans are already underway for trips such as the Youth going to Guatemala and for the annual Colonia 89 trip. And Karan Bridgwater is in the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of a Let's Start Talking (LST) mission trip in Italy! Pleasant Ridge members, from teenagers through senior adults, will plan, prepare for, and carry out short-term missions to countries as close as Mexico and as far away as Zambia.

All of us can't or don't feel led to make such a trip, but all of us can do our part by praying and contributing to these mission trips. During this next week, please pray about and **make plans to participate** in the **special contribution** on ComMission Sunday. There will be two contributions that day, our regular contribution followed immediately by the special contribution for missions.

The other thing that will happen next Sunday in missions is we will be honoring LET'S START TALKING that is celebrating 40 YEARS of doing mission work around the world. This short-term mission sending organization has had an incredible influence on Pleasant Ridge. Because of our relationship with LST through Leslee and Craig Altrock, who have been PR missionaries for 20 years, we have sent PR members on trips all over the world 180 times! This has led to 15,000 hours of reading the Bible with people who need Jesus. And these hours don't include the numerous hours PR members have

volunteered at the Tri-C doing FriendSpeak (the state side name for this mission work)!

March 1<sup>st</sup> is going to be a great day to celebrate and continue to encourage our church family to spread the light of Jesus all over the world. Come be a part!
