

# A NOTE FROM DEAN

As many of you know, my parents are missionaries in American Samoa. They have been there for 15 years. For four of those years, I was in American Samoa with them watching them share Jesus with each and every person they came in contact with. My dad spends his week visiting members of the church, family members of those who have asked for prayers, helping with projects, driving people to work when their car breaks down. He and other members wake up hours before church begins every Sunday morning to go around and pick up many members who wouldn't be able to make it otherwise. My mom is a school teacher and runs the children's program at their church. They both shine a servant light every single day.

I watched them do that throughout my life, but especially during my time as a missionary kid. I see how impactful their work can be. I see people's lives being changed because of their hard work and dedication to their mission. They aren't just sitting on the beach all day not caring about anyone around them. They do meaningful, life-changing work. And that work is supported by people just like you. Churches and individuals from all over the United States help keep them there so they may continue to do the work they have been called to do.

Today is ComMission Sunday and is a great opportunity to help fellow members here make impacts on people around the world. We have mission trips going to Mexico, Guatemala, Zambia, China, and many other places through Let's Start Talking and more. I've seen first-hand the life-change this work can do. This is not insignificant work or meaningless work. It's God's work.
